We, Hitachi Professional Engineers Association members, fulfill the responsibilities of professional engineers stipulated in the Professional Engineer Act and engineers' ethics with the pride and morale of engineers and comply with the following based on the Hitachi Professional Engineers Association Code of Conduct:

1. Giving priority to public interest

We hold paramount the public's safety, health, and welfare.

2. Ensuring sustainability

We strive to facilitate effective use of resources and protect the global environment for the sustainable society.

3. Focusing on competence

- a. We strive to ensure excellent functions and performance as well as reliability in areas where we are competent.
- b. When it is deemed to be difficult to resolve issues, we seek opinions from internal and external stakeholders as well as third-parties and professionals with knowledge and strive to jointly resolve the issues while respecting their competence.

4. Ensuring truthfulness

We strive to make reports and provide explanations using objective information based on facts.

5. Honest and faithful action

- a. We always make judgment and take action with responsibility, honesty, faithfulness, and fairness.
- b. We strive to maintain dignity as engineers by avoiding acts that would damage our credibility such as deceptive acts and receiving or offering of unreasonable rewards.

6. Maintaining confidentiality

We comply with confidentiality obligations. When, however, such information contains information that may have a significant impact on the public, society, and the environment, we strive to disclose information in a timely and appropriate manner.

7. Respect for intellectual efforts and human rights
